Dear Church,

Thank you to everyone who helped us implement some new in-person worship guidelines during Christmas, in order to try and keep our worship space as safe as possible. For this Sunday, January 16th, we will continue our 10am and 5pm services with similar precautionary measures. Parents, please note that nursery coverage will resume this Sunday. Given the rise in cases due to the Omicron variant **we will be maintaining these protocols for the foreseeable future:**

- Attendance will be limited to **30 worshippers** who must [pre-register here](#).
- Attendees must present proof of **vaccination and booster** at the door.
 - If proof of vaccination isn't available, you will be asked to take a rapid COVID test before entering the building. We have a VERY limited number of these tests available for use at both services, please bring proof of vaccination if you have it.
- All attendees must wear an **N95** or **KN95** face mask. We will have an abundant supply of these at the door, with different styles to choose from. Both allow for easy breathing and provide [superior protection](#) to either cloth or surgical masks.
- Attendees will **remain distanced** during the service, including during the passing of the peace.
- Any **children under five** will be directed to the nursery for the duration of the service and will not join their parents in the sanctuary at any point. (Though children are less likely to have severe outcomes from COVID-19, they can also carry it asymptotically and pass it on to others who are at a higher risk.)
- Please be prepared to bundle up, as the **windows will be open** to allow for better air flow in the space. The upgraded **MERV filters** and **additional air purifiers** will also be in use.

We hope you are staying safe and that we might see you soon, as you're able! We will keep you updated as guidelines change and as we monitor the situation. Please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions. Every blessing in this New Year.
